**WHAT IF THE FBI OR POLICE COME TO MY  
HOME?**

**YOU HAVE THE RIGHT NOT TO ANSWER QUESTIONS.** Remaining silent is not a crime. ANY information you give to an officer, even if it seems harmless, can be used against you or someone else. Lying to an officer is a crime.

**YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO TALK TO AN ATTORNEY FIRST.**

It is *your* right and choice whether to get an attorney. However, if you are not a U.S. citizen, it is even more important that you talk to an attorney first.

**YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO ALLOW AN OFFICER INTO YOUR HOME** without a warrant. Ask to see the warrant. If the officer refuses to show it to you, do not let the officer in. If the officer has a warrant for your arrest, **do not talk until you consult with an attorney first.**
